TO PROMOTE COMPLIANCE BY NATIONALS OF CONTRACTING PARTIES AND COOPERATING NON-CONTRACTING PARTIES WITH IOTC CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES

**REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

This resolution aims to curb potential illegal fishing behaviour by natural (individuals) or legal persons (companies), by requiring States to effectively subject them to their jurisdiction, and sanction them for proven offences. This approach is based on the tenets of the IPOA-IUU on the same matter, enshrined in its paragraphs 9.3, 18 and 19. It addresses all Member States equally. The resolution addresses a critical IPOA-IUU requirement on taking measures to discourage nationals subject to a State's jurisdiction from supporting or engaging in IUU fishing activities.

This resolution establishes a single event-based reporting requirement, relating to actions and measures taken on natural or legal persons.

Submit report on actions and measures taken against natural or legal persons involved in IUU fishing activities

WHEN**DEADLINES**

Any time (event-based reporting)

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: FORMAT AND CONTENT

The resolution exhorts States to investigate and sanction their nationals with links to vessels listed in the IOTC IUU list (paragraph 1). CPCs are required to submit reports on actions and measures undertaken against natural or legal persons involved in IUU fishing activities (paragraph 2).

REPORTING REQUIREMENT 1:

SUBMIT REPORT ON ACTIONS AND MEASURES TAKEN UNDER THIS RESOLUTION, AGAINST NATURAL OR LEGAL PERSONS INVOLVED IN IUU ACTIVITIES.

IMPLEMENTATION

- How to report: There is no set template to report information on cases and measures taken. CPCs are encouraged to submit this report in the form they deem fit, ensuring to cover the following items: a) established infraction, and; b) sanctions levelled against the offender(s).
- Reporting format: National report – ideally in MS Word or pdf file format.
- Where to send the information: The report should be mailed to iotc-secretariat@fao.org

COOPERATION REQUIREMENTS

CPCs are required to cooperate in the investigation of offences.
