# REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

There is one reporting requirement: to the Non-CPC flag State of the vessel to the IOTC Secretariat on such an observation/inspection indicating there are grounds for believing that this vessel is fishing contrary to IOTC Conservation or Management Measures.

The reporting requirement applies equally to flag, coastal, port and market States.

# CPC ALL STATES WHAT Report observation or inspection information and data to the flag State of the Non-CPC flagged vessel and the IOTC Secretariat WHEN DEADLINES Upon each incident

# REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: FORMAT AND CONTENT

One specific reporting template have been developed by the Secretariat, to facilitate the submission of data on such incidents.

REPORTING REQUIREMENT 1:
REPORT OBSERVATION TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE FLAG STATE OF THE NON-CPC FLAGGED VESSEL, AND TO THE IOTC SECRETARIAT

#### **IMPLEMENTATION**

- <u>How to report:</u> Flag and Coastal States ought to use the word template form developed for this exercise.
- Reporting format: The report must be submitted in specified file format. The template spreadsheet form can be accessed under http://www.iotc.org/compliance/reporting-templates
- Where to send the report: The report should be mailed to the flag State of the Non-CPC flagged fishing vessel and to *iotc-secretariat@fao.org*

The IOTC Executive Secretary shall:

The Commission or its subsidiary bodies will not become involved in the issue unless any one of the State-types decide to list the Non-CPC flagged fishing vessel as an IUU fishing vessel, at which time the IUU listing procedures come into effect.
